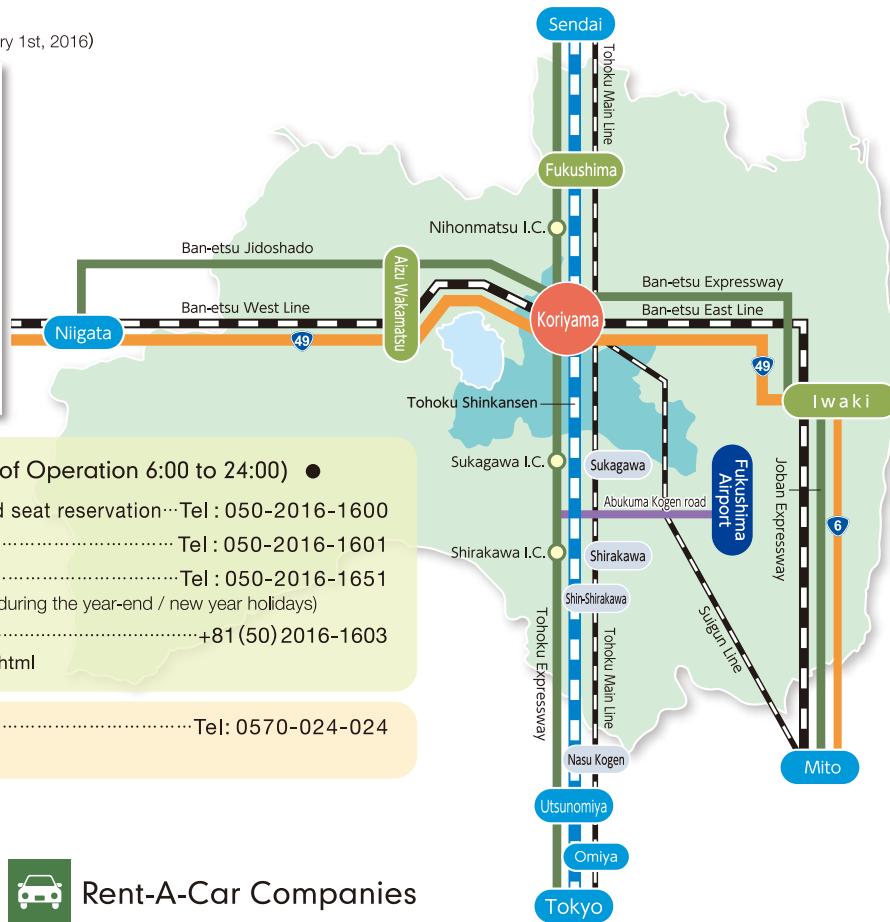

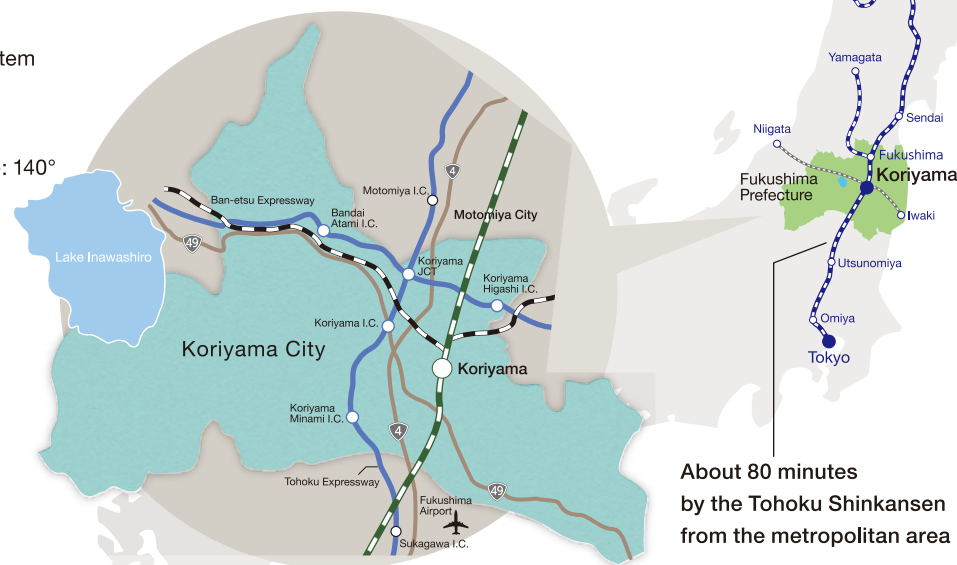

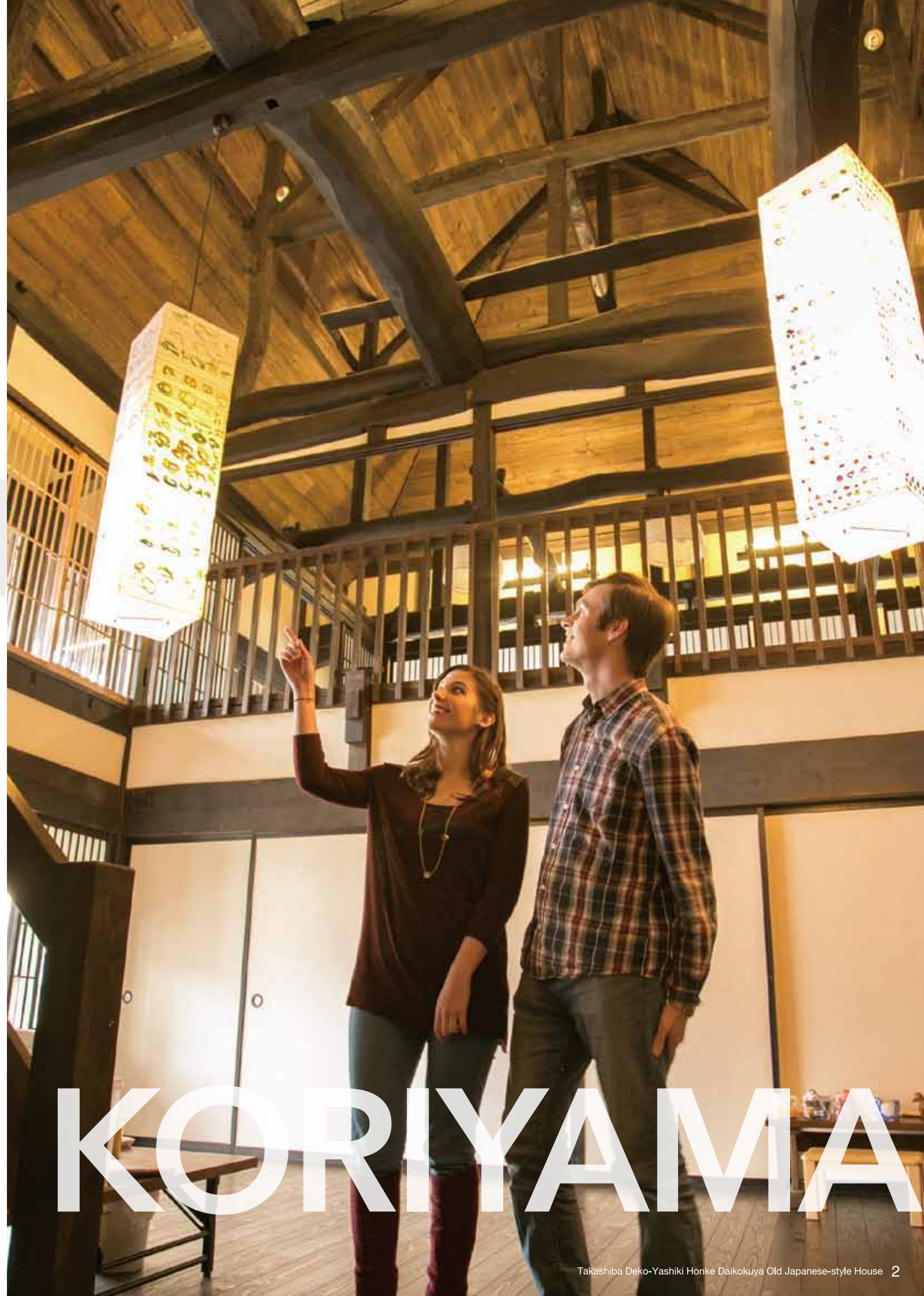

## Cherry Trees at Kaiseizan Park

Kaiseizan park is a popular place for citizens to relax, and it is also a symbol of Asaka pioneering to be the foundation of development of Koriyama City. The park is one of the best spots in Fukushima, and there are 1,300 cherry trees planted there. The trees are lit up at night when they are in full bloom.

## Nunobiki Kaze no Highland Sunflower field

# The story “The single canal that opened up the future — Ōkubo Toshimichi’s ‘final dream’ and the tracks of the pioneers; Koriyama and Inawashiro —” has been designated as ‘Japan Heritage’.

The land development of Kaiseizan began in 1873 and gradually spread all over the region. ‘The Asaka Land Development and Asaka Canal Works,’ which drew water for irrigation from Lake Inawashiro, was the Meiji government’s first nationally run agricultural development project. Through this story, you will experience the history of the rapid modernization of Koriyama.

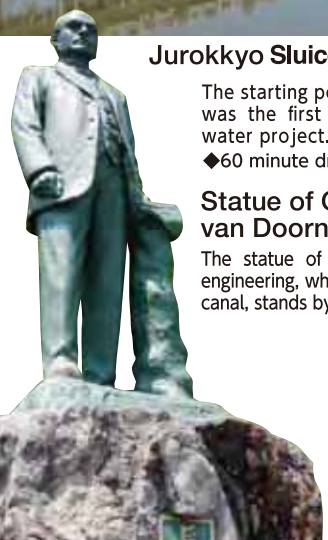
The development of the plains around Kaiseizan started in 1873 and expanded to the entire Asakano area. ‘Asaka Land Development Project’, which was the first state-operated Land Development Project in the Meiji era, and ‘Asaka Canal Cultivation’ to irrigate water from Lake Inawashiro served as the foundation for Koriyama to develop.



### Jurokkyo Sluice Gate (Inawashiro-Town)

The starting point of the drainage works. It was the first state-operated agricultural water project.

### Statue of Cornelis Johannes van Doorn (Inawashiro-town)

The statue of a Dutch expert in hydraulic engineering, who contributed by designing the canal, stands by the Sluice.



### Numagami Power Plant

The hydroelectric power plant was Japan’s first facility to transmit high-voltage power over long distances.

### Kaiseikan

The museum exhibits materials related to the history of the Asaka Land Development Project and Asaka Canal.

### Asaka Historical Museum

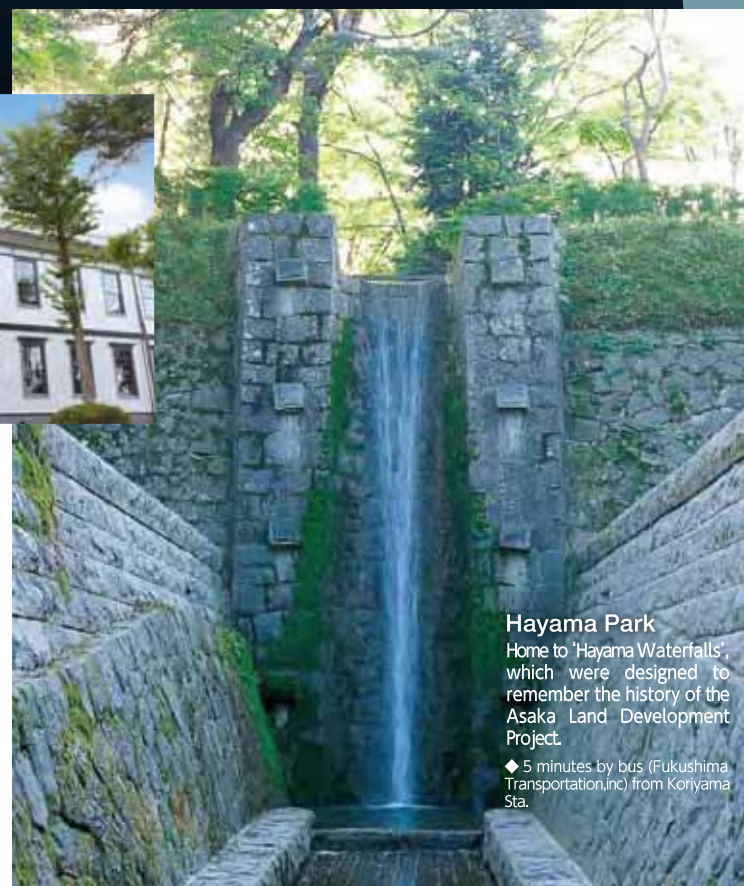
In 1889, the main building of the former Fukushima Junior High School was established on the site of Asaka Land Development Project. It is now open to the public as a historical museum.

### Hayama Park

Home to ‘Hayama Waterfalls’, which were designed to remember the history of the Asaka Land Development Project.

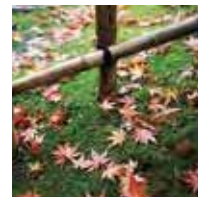
### Legend of Hagihime

It is said that a daughter of a Court noble in ancient Kyoto visited here and she recovered from an incurable disease.



The hot spring has a good reputation as a "Hot Spring of Beauty", making visitors' skin smooth with the refreshing water since times gone by.

It was opened about 800 years ago. It is an alkaline simple hot spring and the water is kind to the skin. It is very popular as a "Hot Springs of Beauty" and famously effective for burns, injuries, and skin diseases as well.

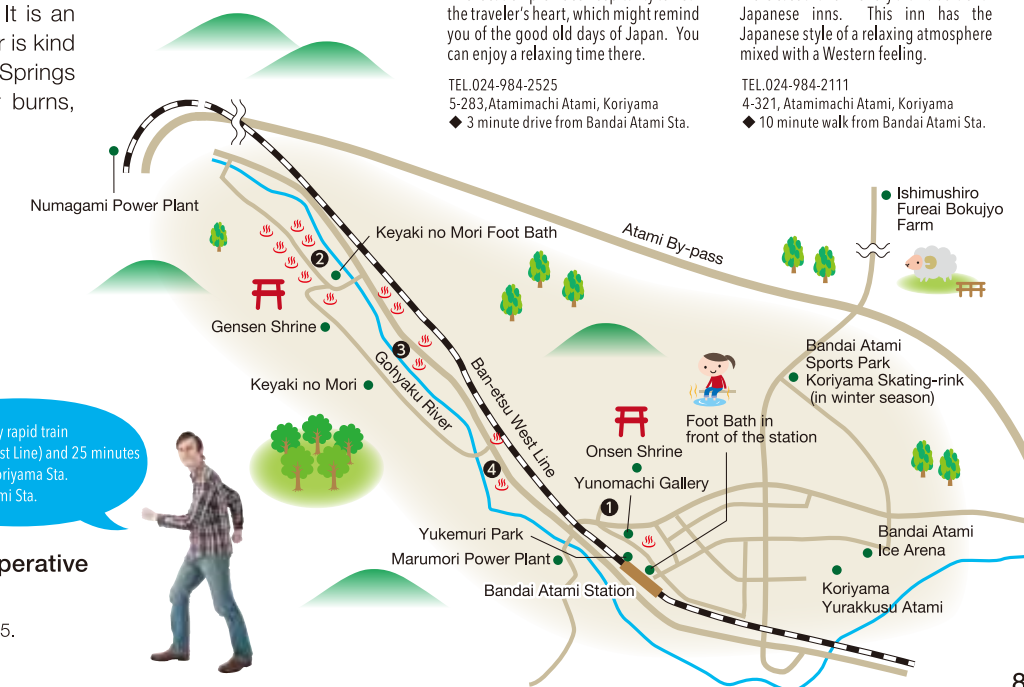

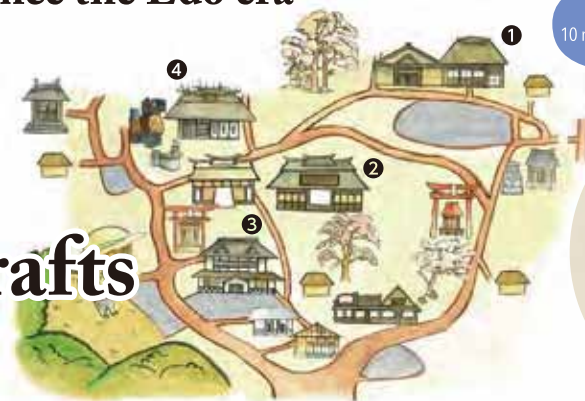


### What is Takashiba Deko Yashiki?

Originally, this was a village for craftsmen who were protected in the Miharu Domain during the Edo period (1603–1868). Takashiba Deko Yashiki is believed to have been established by people who came from Kyoto in Miharu 300 years ago. These people passed on the tradition of how to make these dolls.

## The Birthplace of Miharu Goma & Miharu Hariko

### Hariko Doll

Takashiba's Hariko dolls were created in the Genroku era (17th-18th century). Many of them were designed based on the style of painting and a kind of Ukiyo-e at that time. Layered Japanese paper is used to make the doll.

### Takashiba Deko Festival

Everyone can join!  
'Takashiba Hyottoko Odori', a dance wearing Hariko masks, and 'Takashiba and Shichifukujin Odori', which are designated as important intangible folk cultural assets by Koriyama City, are performed on the last Sunday in May every year.



### Hariko Mask

Hariko masks like Shichifukujin, Hyottoko, and Otafuku are also well-known as traditional folk crafts from the Takashiba district.



### Miharugoma

The miharugoma is a wooden craft toy, which was used in the design for Japan's first postage stamp to be used on special Japanese New Year cards. The toy is also considered to be a lucky charm, signifying the healthy growth and long life of children.

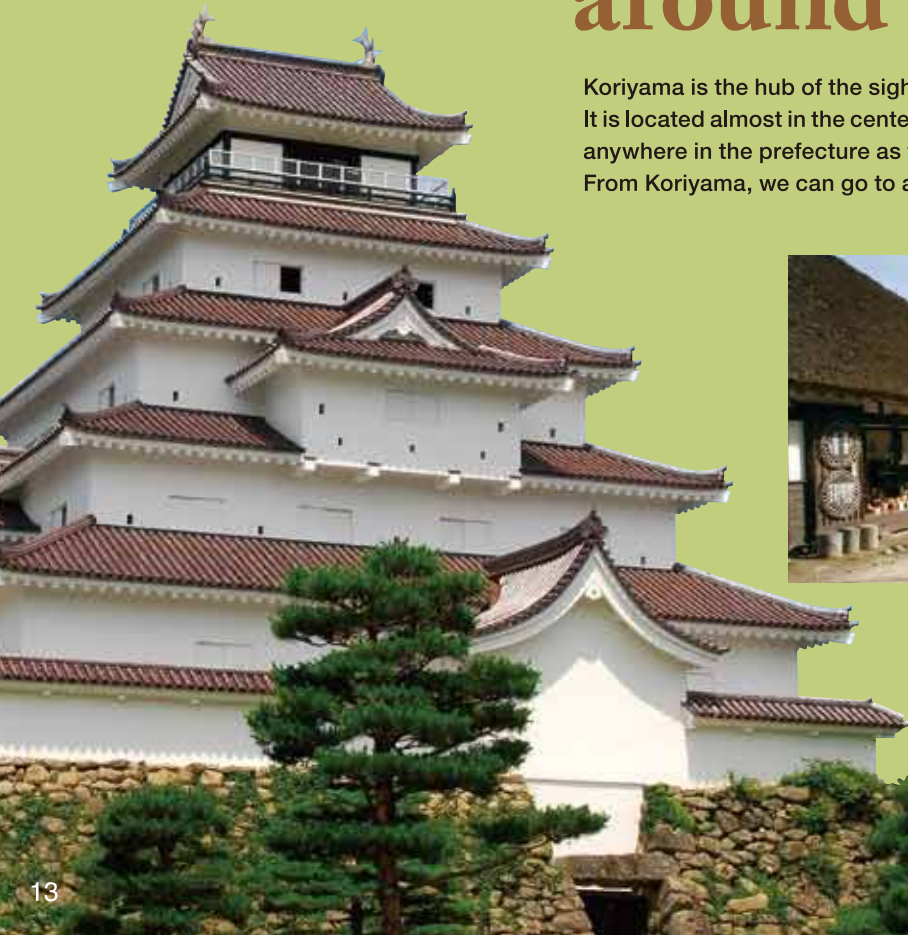


### Sauce Katsu Don

Hot springs are not swimming pools. You cannot swim there even if they are large enough.
